



Headwaters Real Estate Recap: to FEBRUARY 28, 2015

With the weather starting to warm up, so are home sales and inventory in the Headwaters region of Orangeville, Dufferin County, Caledon and Erin. In February sales increased to 161, which is up compared to January of this year (113), and February of 2014 (135). Inventory has also risen to 500 listings for sale in the Headwaters region. Homebuyers seem to be ready to jump on new listings this year, as the inventory starts to rise. Out of the 161 listings sold in February, 45 lasted less than 10 days on the market! In addition to this, 22 of these listings sold for full asking price or higher. The average sale to list price out of these 22 listings was 102%; the highest being 115%. This goes to show, if a house is priced right and shows well, the Buyers are willing to compete and pay higher than asking.

The *major* influx of inventory has not yet hit the market, and with most listings selling quite quickly, the inventory might take a while to peak this spring. With these recent stats, <u>February was definitely a Seller's market</u>. The spring market is here!!!
