



Inspired by John McCrae's "In Flanders Fields", Madame Anna Guérin, later christened "The Poppy Lady from France" campaigned tirelessly in the early 1920s for her Inter-Allied Poppy Day idea: to adopt the distribution of the Poppy on Armistice Day as a way to raise money for Veterans' needs and to remember those who had given their lives during the First World War.

After meeting with her, on 5 July 1921 the Great War Veterans Association (which in 1925 would unify with other Veteran groups to form the Canadian Legion) adopted the Poppy as the flower of Remembrance.

To celebrate this 100th anniversary, The Royal **Canadian Legion has produced this commemorative** Poppy, a pin reminiscent of the first Poppies distributed in Canada after the First World War.

The local market is still red hot!

With the chillier weather here, it hasn't deterred buyer and seller activity in the Headwaters region.

In Orangeville average sale price is hovering around the mid \$800,000 mark, with average list to sale price ratio of 105%. Homes in town are selling quickly, with an average of 12 days on market. Average sale price in October of 2020 was only \$653,605, which is up a whopping 29% comparing to October 2021. Currently there are only 23 active freehold listings available in town, and 5 are conditionally sold leaving active buyers a choice of only 18 listings.

Again, supply and demand seems to be the driving force in the price increase and fast market activity. Let's hope we see some more inventory hit the market in November before the Christmas season!
